**Jennifer Reason**, pianist/vocalist, is a California native who has spent her life in music. She developed her passion for performance at a very early age, and gave her first solo recital at the age of 5, acquired her first staff pianist position at the tender age of 12, and eventually graduated with a Bachelor of Music degree in piano performance from California State University at Sacramento. Hailed by German critics as a "rising star" who's playing is "lush, sensual and colorful-like a painting," she has gone on to earn solo and ensemble performances across Europe, Canada, and the United States, a Carnegie Hall debut in May of 2012, and several prestigious awards, including the Bank of America Achievement Award in Music, a lifetime membership in the Pi Kappa Lambda national music honor society, and a Special Citation from the International Association for Jazz Education for Outstanding Musicianship. In addition to her solo work, Jennifer divides her time among several diverse ensembles, including: RSVP-an *a capella* vocal ensemble benefitting local charities, Citywater- a New American music ensemble, Camellia Symphony, Classical Revolution Sacramento, the Sacramento Children's Chorus, and several local musical theater companies. She is looking forward to returning to Europe for a sixth time later this year as a guest performer for both the InterHarmony International Music Festival in Germany and the Festival of Peace and Brotherhood in Rome.
